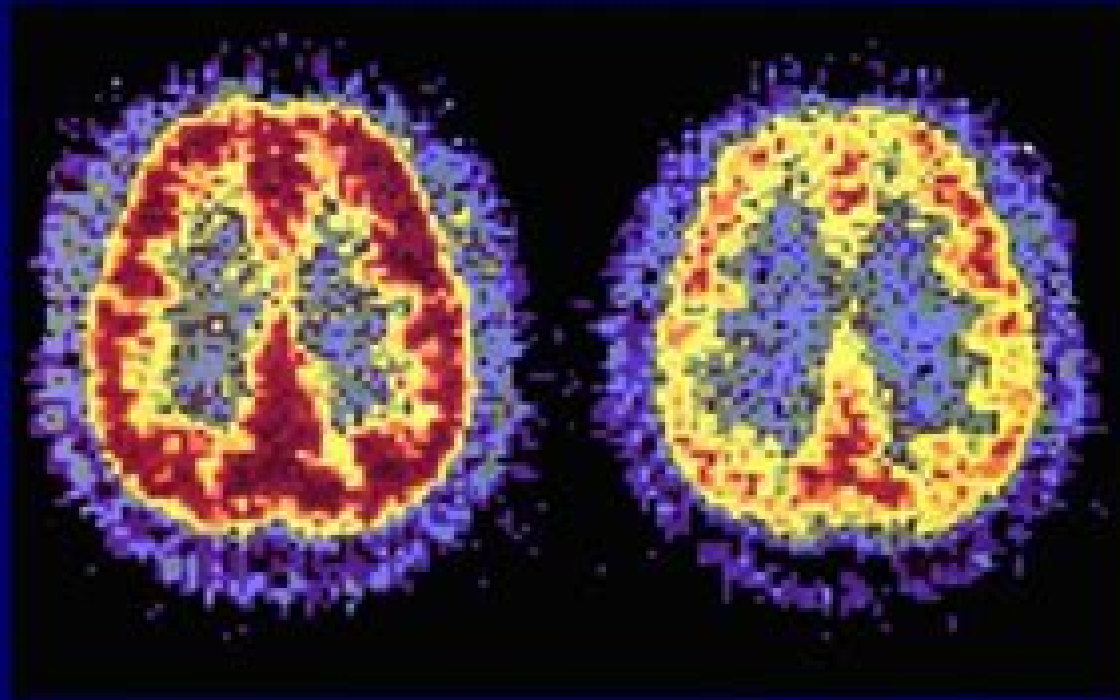

response he explains that we can begin to understand why addicts experience cravings long after their last drug use
