beginnings as the Sumarian civilization in Mesopotamia through the present day **Illness as Narrative** Ann Jurečič, 2012-03-12 For most of literary history personal confessions about illness were considered too intimate to share publicly By the mid twentieth century however a series of events set the stage for the emergence of the illness narrative The increase of chronic disease the transformation of medicine into big business the women s health movement the AIDS HIV pandemic the advent of inexpensive paperbacks and the rise of self publishing all contributed to the proliferation of narratives about encounters with medicine and mortality While the illness narrative is now a staple of the publishing industry the genre itself has posed a problem for literary studies What is the role of criticism in relation to personal accounts of suffering Can these narratives be judged on aesthetic grounds Are they a collective expression of the lost intimacy of the patient doctor relationship Is their function thus instrumental to elicit the reader s empathy To answer these questions Ann Jurecic turns to major works on pain and suffering by Susan Sontag Elaine Scarry and Eve Sedgwick and reads these alongside illness narratives by Jean Dominique Bauby Reynolds Price and Anne Fadiman among others In the process she defines the subgenres of risk and pain narratives and explores a range of critical responses guided alternately by narrative empathy the hermeneutics of suspicion and the practice of reparative reading *Illness as Narrative* seeks to draw wider attention to this form of life writing and to argue for new approaches to both literary criticism and teaching narrative Jurecic calls for a practice that s both compassionate and critical She asks that we consider why writers compose stories of illness how readers receive them and how both use these narratives to make meaning of human fragility and mortality **In Praise of Forgetting** David Rieff, 2016-05-10 The conventional wisdom about historical memory is summed up in George Santayana s celebrated phrase Those who cannot remember the past are condemned to repeat it Today the consensus that it is moral to remember immoral to forget is nearly absolute And yet is this right David Rieff an independent writer who has reported on bloody conflicts in Africa the Balkans and Central Asia insists that things are not so simple He poses hard questions about whether remembrance ever truly has or indeed ever could inoculate the present against repeating the crimes of the past He argues that rubbing raw historical wounds whether self inflicted or imposed by outside forces neither remedies injustice nor confers reconciliation If he is right then historical memory is not a moral imperative but rather a moral option sometimes called for sometimes not Collective remembrance can be toxic Sometimes Rieff concludes it may be more moral to forget Ranging widely across some of the defining conflicts of modern times the Irish Troubles and the Easter Uprising of 1916 the white settlement of Australia the American Civil War the Balkan wars the Holocaust and 9 11 Rieff presents a pellucid examination of the uses and abuses of historical memory His contentious brilliant and elegant essay is an indispensable work of moral philosophy *US Defense Politics* Harvey M. impunity ensuring deterrence and bringing about reconciliation The contributors to the volume are all noted scholars some of whom specialize in the study of genocide and others who specialize in such areas as early warning peacekeeping and sanctions
