the very ambiguity in the relationship between the ideal subjects that these market and legal visions promote respectively post national entrepreneur and citizen is that which permits a space for resistance and politics Thus the book argues for a pragmatic politics which is cognizant of the violent potential inherent in any cosmopolitan attempt to govern Europe while recognising the contemporary dangers associated with the dominance of a market cosmopolitan Europe This work is an important and timely intervention in contemporary debates about democratic Europe and its shortcomings and will be of great interest to scholars of international political theory European studies and international political economy
