

Art's Undoing: In the Wake of a Radical Aestheticism. By Forest Pyle.
New York: Fordham University Press, 2014. 328 pp.

This ambitious, intellectually captivating book gives appropriate conceptual form to a subject matter that is all but unbearable to represent. The subject of *Art's Undoing* is an aestheticism that the Romantics and their successors did not espouse, commit, or undertake (3, 5, 6, 64, 148). Forest Pyle traces in art an intensity not compatible with its profession: “a *radical aestheticism* that offers no positive claims for art (either those based on ethical or political grounds or on aesthetic grounds, as in ‘art for art’s sake’)” and “provides ‘no transcendent or underlying ground’ for their validation” (4). Nor is Pyle’s concept of “radical aestheticism” understandable as the articulation of an oeuvre—the conduct of a writer’s professional project. An unthreaded sequence of alternately radiant and cindery moments provides the arresting features in this account, prised apart from the dominance of individual careers in ongoing motion and of literary history told as an intelligible, grand pattern (12).

Despite its resistance to “major” narrative lines, *Art's Undoing* will prove essential reading for scholars in Romantic and nineteenth-century literature and, by modeling a fascinating approach to problems of contemporary critical aesthetics, should win many admirers. The book spans from Percy Shelley to Oscar Wilde, rather than from the more familiar William Wordsworth to W. B. Yeats, Rainer Maria Rilke, or Wallace Stevens, and shuns the empty positivism that defines meaning by national histories or continuous century markers. (The poverty of such “secularism” is featured in Pyle’s last chapter, on “Wilde’s extravagance” in *Solmsé*.) Without needing openly to declare his freedom from the template of comparative literature scholarship of a generation or two ago, Pyle reaps a “negative harvesting” of unapologetic Romanticism and post-Romanticism, under no compulsion either to modify or to fight the narrative of modernist resentment (the quoted phrase [106] is from Anne-Lise François [2008: 146] on Emily Dickinson).

At the end of Pyle’s introduction, “From Which One Turns Away,” a reading of Théodore Géricault’s painting *The Raft of the Medusa* (1819) introduces the book’s core theme and sponsors a reading method for the study as a whole by analyzing and inducing the “Medusa effect” of critical “aversion” (21).¹ According to Pyle, criticism typically turns away from “irreducible formal, rhetorical, and thematic elements” in texts, even while it shows itself answerable to art’s ethical aspects (21). Still, he is no formalist seeking closure

Arts Undoing In The Wake Of A Radical Aestheticism:

retrospectively Yet they shape the aims technique and ultimately the whole affective economy of Wordsworth s writing Rather than understanding the domain of pleasure to be strictly subjective personal experience Wordsworth posits affects and attachments beyond conscious experience or possession Teasing apart unremembered pleasure from the psychoanalytic concepts of sublimation repression and trauma the book offers new interpretations of both well known and marginal poems rethinking familiar oppositions between childhood and maturity and between sensation and recollection By tracing affects which are not determinate sensations so much as unacknowledged gifts it demonstrates how retrospective pleasure undercuts fantasies of purely autonomous experience It argues for the centrality of surprise unremembered pleasure promises to disturb catch out and remake the person who encounters it More broadly it locates in Wordsworth s account of composition the resources to rethink poetic pleasure not as wish fulfilment nor as aesthetic escape but as an engaged and reparative relation to the world Book jacket **Percy Shelley For Our Times** Omar F. Tavlin,2023-06-13 The sweeping vantages that typify American landscape painting from the nineteenth century by Thomas Cole and other members of the Hudson School are often interpreted for their geopolitical connotations as visual attempts to tame the wild alleviating fears of a savage frontier through views that subdue the landscape to the eye Zachary Tavlin s Glancing Visions challenges the long standing assumption that visibility in nineteenth century art and literature was inherently imperialistic or possessive While there is much to be said for both material economic and theological impulses to clear the wilderness superimpose a national identity and usher in a Puritanical idyll many literary figures of the era display a purposeful disdain for the possessive gaze signaling instead a preference for subtle glances often informed by early photography Impressionism new techniques in portraiture and soon after the dawn of cinema The visual subjectivities and contingencies introduced by these media made room for a visual counter narrative one informed by a mode of seeing that

moves fast and lightly across the surface of things Tavlin probes Nathaniel Hawthorne's idea of the imagination one that derives from both the camera obscura in *The Custom House* and the daguerreotype in *The House of the Seven Gables* each in its way an instance of the glance and entirely dependent on temporal moments The poetry of Frances Ellen Watkins Harper toggles between gazes and glances unsettling two competing forms of racialized seeing as they pertain to nineteenth century Black life and racial hierarchies the sentimental gaze and the slave trader's glance highlighting the life and death stakes of both looking anyone squarely in the eye and looking away Emily Dickinson's certain slant of light syntactical oddities and her stitching of scraps and fragments into the fascicles that constitute her corpus all derive from a commitment to contingency the ungrounded life's only defense against the abyss of non being Tavlin investigates as well Henry James's vexed but entirely dependent relationship to literary and painterly impressionism and William Carlos Williams's imagist poetics as a response to early cinema's use of the cut as the basis for a new visual grammar Each of these literary artists Tavlin argues via their own distinctive sensibilities and the artistic or technological counterparts that informed them refuse the authoritative all possessive gaze in favor of the glance a mode of seeing thinking and being that made way for what we now think of as commonplace namely modernity

Look Round for Poetry Brian McGrath, 2022-05-17. Poetry is dead. Poetry is all around us. Both are trite truisms that this book exploits and challenges. In his 1798 *Advertisement to Lyrical Ballads*, William Wordsworth anticipates that readers accustomed to the poetic norms of the day might not recognize his experiments as poems and might signal their awkward confusion upon opening the book by looking round for poetry as if seeking it elsewhere. *Look Round for Poetry* transforms Wordsworth's idiomatic expression into a methodological charge. By placing tropes and figures common to Romantic and Post-Romantic poems in conjunction with contemporary economic, technological, and political discourse, *Look Round for Poetry* identifies poetry's untimely echoes in discourses not always read as poetry or not always read poetically. Once one begins looking round for poetry, McGrath insists, one might discover it in some surprising contexts. In chapters that spring from poems by Wordsworth, Lucille Clifton, John Keats, and Percy Bysshe Shelley, McGrath reads poetic examples of

understatement alongside market demands for more the downturned brow as a figure for economic catastrophe Romantic cloud metaphors alongside the rhetoric of cloud computing the election of the dead as a poetical and not just a political act and poetic investigations into the power of prepositions as theories of political assembly For poetry to retain a vital power McGrath argues we need to become ignorant of what we think we mean by it In the process we may discover critical vocabularies that engage the complexity of social life all around us

Poetics and the Gift Adam R. Rosenthal, 2022 Using a broad comparative approach this study shows how the figure of the gift structures poetic discourse and does so from the age of Homer up through twenty first century conceptual poetics Beginning from a new interpretation of Derrida's writings on the gift Adam R Rosenthal argues that this ambivalent figure names at one and the same time poetry's most extreme aneconomic privilege and the point of its closest contact with the interested exchange of the market In this way the gift conducts material relays of patronage and theories of poetic origination in genius inspiration and imagination Poetics and the Gift capitalizes on this double function in order to read material historical accounts of poetry alongside philosophical and poetic ones By way of his original reading of Derrida's work in *Given Time* and *Economimesis* Rosenthal offers a novel account of gift poetics and a new understanding of what makes poetry poetry

Lives of the Dead Poets Karen Swann, 2019-04-02 Any reader engaging the work of Keats Shelley or Coleridge must confront the role biography has played in the canonization of each Each archive is saturated with stories of the life prematurely cut off or in Coleridge's case of promise wasted in indolence One confronts reminiscences of contemporaries who describe subjects singularly unsuited to this world as well as still stranger materials death masks bits of bone locks of hair a heart initially preserved by circles and then circulating more widely often in tandem with bits of the literary corpus Especially when it centers on the early deaths of Keats and Shelley biographical interest tends to be dismissed as a largely Victorian and sentimental phenomenon that we should by now have put behind us And yet a line of verse by these poets can still trigger associations with biographical detail in ways that spark pathos or produce intimations of prolepsis or fatality even
