mirrored the current changing social order conventions and policies in the 1960s as well as in the 1970s and 1980s. Nevertheless the women presented in this book were instrumental in advancing and consolidating the social transformation that happened within the space community and the United States and therefore make intriguing subjects of research. Thus this systematic analysis of the connection between gender space and the Cold War adds a new dimension to space history as well as expands the discourse in American history about gender relations and the opportunities of women in the twentieth century.
