man leaves the Yukon Trail after being warned of the dangers of the trip by locals With nine hours of hiking ahead of him the man is expecting to meet his associates at a mining claim in Henderson Creek that evening The man is accompanied only by a large husky dog whose instincts tell it that the weather is too cold for traveling However the weather does not deter the man a relative newcomer to the Yukon even though the water vapor in the man s exhaled breaths and the saliva from the tobacco he is chewing have frozen his mouth shut As he hikes along a creek he takes care to avoid pockets of unfrozen water hidden beneath thin layers of ice He stops to build a fire and thaw out so he can eat his lunch but after he begins hiking again he breaks through the ice and soaks his feet and lower legs
