



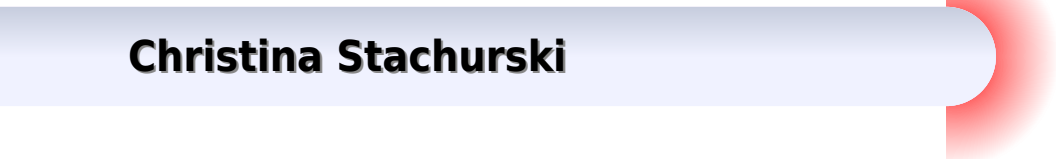

Georges Baudoux's Jean M'Barai The Trepang Fisherman Karin Speedy, 2015-01-01 Between 1860 and 1910 Australian governments sanctioned and then tried to stop the trafficking of South Sea Islanders to Queensland as forced labourers Over 60 000 Islanders were lured from their villages tricked transported forced to work in the harsh Queensland bush and then repatriated Most Islanders returned with little savings to find their communities deeply scarred by the blackbirding trade and the internecine tribal conflict it had provoked Georges Baudoux 1865 1949 was brought up amongst the Islanders who experienced the raw and competing greed of French British and Australian colonialism Son of a French prison commander stationed in New Caledonia Baudoux lead a colourful life amongst the Pacific islands and deep in the brousse bush before becoming an author and capturing the stories of his travels and importantly the experiences of friends and colleagues as life in the islands changed forever In recognition of his work he was awarded the esteemed Palmes Acad miques the French medal for literary and academic achievement Jean M Barai is one of his best works Expertly translated by Dr Karin Speedy and published here in English for the first time this book exposes the rich complex and brutal world of a South Sea Islander caught up in the duplicitous trade that came to be known as Blackbirding It is an exciting provocative and

Panguru and the City: Kāinga Tahi, Kāinga Rua Melissa Matutina Williams, 2016-03-09 Travelling from Hokianga to Auckland in the middle decades of the twentieth century the people of Panguru established themselves in the workplaces suburbs churches and schools of the city Melissa Matutina Williams writes from the heart of these communities The daughter of a Panguru family growing up in Auckland she writes a perceptive account of urban migration through the stories of the Panguru migrants Through these vibrant oral narratives the history of M ori migration is relocated to the tribal and wh nau context in which it occurred For the people of Panguru migration was seldom viewed as a one way journey of new beginnings it was experienced as a lifelong process of developing a coexistent home place for themselves and future generations Dreams of a brighter future drew on the cultural foundations of a tribal homeland and past Panguru and the City K inga Tahi K inga Rua traces their negotiations with people and places from Auckland s inner city boarding houses places of worship and dance halls to workplaces and Maori Affairs homes in the suburbs It is a history that will resonate with M ori from all tribal areas who shared in the quiet task of working against state policies of assimilation the economic challenges of the 1970s and neoliberal policies of the 1980s in order to develop dynamic M ori community sites and networks which often remained invisible in the cities of Aotearoa New Zealand
