    - First people likely came over 20,000 to 25,000 years ago during a warming trend following mammoths, musk over, and wholly chanceroses
    - Eventually, ice returned, and magrants pushed inland.
    - Manimoth's disappeared approx. 10,000; people became dependent on fish, plants, other meats to survive.
    - Some communities began establishing agriculture, led to permanent settlements

    - Beans, squash, and corn offered a well-rounded duet
    - High yields produced surpluses of food allowed for trade
