When multiplying 2×8 , you can break 8 up into 2 + 6.

$$2 \times 8 \qquad = \qquad 2 \times (2+6) \qquad = (2 \times 2) + (2 \times 6)$$

Any way you solve the equivalent expressions, the product is the same.
