Shafarevich, 2012-12-06 The algebra of square matrices of size $n \times n$ over the field of complex numbers is evidently the best known example of a non commutative algebra Subalgebras and subrings of this algebra for example the ring of $n \times n$ matrices with integral entries arise naturally in many areas of mathematics Historically however the study of matrix algebras was preceded by the discovery of quaternions which introduced in 1843 by Hamilton found applications in the classical mechanics of the past century Later it turned out that quaternion analysis had important applications in field theory The algebra of quaternions has become one of the classical mathematical objects it is used for instance in algebra geometry and topology We will briefly focus on other examples of non commutative rings and algebras which arise naturally in mathematics and in mathematical physics The exterior algebra or Grassmann algebra is widely used in differential geometry for example in geometric theory of integration Clifford algebras which include exterior algebras as a special case have applications in representation theory and in algebraic topology The Weyl algebra The algebra of differential operators with polynomial coefficients often appears in the representation theory of Lie algebras In recent years modules over the Weyl algebra and sheaves of such modules became the foundation of the so called microlocal analysis The theory of operator algebras
