Shea, 2016-07-01 Bicycles have more cultural identities than many realize functioning not only as literal vehicles in a text but also as vehicles for that text s themes ideas and critiques In the late nineteenth century the bicycle was seen as a way for the wealthy urban elite to reconnect with nature and for women to gain a measure of personal freedom while during World War II it became a utilitarian tool of the French Resistance and in 1970s China stood for wealth and modernization Lately it has functioned variously as the favored ideological steed of environmentalists a means of community
