Psychosis is a symptom of a disordered brain. Approximately One percent of the population worldwide develops schizophrenia during their lifetime. Although schizophrenia affects men and women with equal frequency the disorder often appears earlier in men usually in the late teens or early twenties than in women who are generally affected in the twenties to early thirties. People with schizophrenia often suffer symptoms such as hearing internal voices not heard by others or believing that other people are reading their minds controlling their thoughts or plotting to harm them.
